

## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO SEEK PROPONENTS FOR RECALL PETITION

**TO THE Honorable Terry A. Hansen:** Pursuant to Section 11020, California Elections Code, the undersigned registered qualified voters in the State of California, hereby give notice that we are the proponents of a recall petition and that we intend to seek your recall and removal from the bench, in the State of California, and to demand election of successors in that office.

### The grounds for the recall are as follows:

*A complaint has been submitted to you as the Yuba Co Voter Registrar stating that Mr. Barry Soetoro (aka Barack Hussein Obama) is not qualified to be on the 2012 Primary ballot. He is not qualified as mandated by Article II of the US Constitution. All candidates must be natural born citizens; a person who's Father and Mother are both U. S. Citizens and who has been born on U.S. soil. Mr. Soetoro's father is a foreign national of Kenyan and no US birth certificate can be found to verify his citizenship. This makes Mr. Soetoro ineligible to hold the office of President of the U.S.*

*Complaints have been submitted to you stating that Mr. Soetoro is using bogus birth certificates, stolen social security numbers and a false Selective Service card to identify himself to the voters throughout the United States. You have failed to report these crimes to the proper authorities.*

*You have failed to acknowledge this complaint as part of your duties as Yuba County Voter Registrar. You merely say "the Election Law" forces you to pass the matter on to someone else. Therefore we intend to recall you.*

This is not a RECALL PETITION but a **pre-recall event**. If enough proponents are found then the procedure under **Elections Code section 11023 will be followed. The procedure will be as follows: 1) A Notice of Intention to Recall will be filed.**

(a) Within seven days after the filing of the notice of intention, the officer sought to be recalled may file with the elections official, or in the case of a state officer, the Secretary of State, an answer, in not more than 200 words, to the statement of the proponents.

(b) If an answer is filed, the officer shall, within seven days after the filing of the notice of intention, also serve a copy of it, by personal delivery or by certified mail, on one of the proponents named in the notice of intention.

(c) The answer shall be signed and shall be accompanied by the printed name and business or residence address of the officer to be recalled.
